April 13th 2025: Palm Sunday Passiontide

Please pray this week for the people of St Nicholas Church, Deeping St Nicholas, their priest Revd Erica Crust and their outreach into their community.

Holy Week & Easter: Sunday 13th - Sunday 20th April Palm Sunday: We begin in The Rectory Paddock, 10am, then make the short walk to church, singing songs, to continue the service. At 5pm, join us for prayerful activities using prayer stations around church, which reflect the themes of our recent Lent Course. They will also be available throughout Holy Week so you can take a prayer walk at a time to suit you.

Monday - Wednesday: 7.30pm, Compline

Maundy Thursday: At 7pm, we start in the Green School for Holy Communion in the context of a meal. Please sign up if you wish to come, indicating if you are able to provide any food. Then we move to church quietly for the stripping of the altar leading into the vigil.

Good Friday: The annual Churches Together Walk of Witness starts in St Guthlac's at 10am. Easter crafts at 10.30am in the Green School is a family friendly time of activities, crafts, and story, with hot cross buns! At 2pm we have a reflective service with Bible readings, prayers, quiet times, hymns, and a short talk to guide our thinking on this solemn day.

Easter Day: At 10am we celebrate Jesus' resurrection with an All Age Holy Communion Service, with a little fire outside the church and the lighting of the Easter candle, followed by an outdoor Easter egg hunt for the children and coffee and hot cross buns for adults.

Annual Parochial Church Meeting: The business meeting of the parish takes place on Sunday 27th April. This year it will be part of the 10am service in place of a sermon and reports (sent by email prior to the meeting) will be accepted from the Rector, treasurer, wardens etc. We urge you all to attend and there will be no 8am service that day.
